1. Leave People and Places Better Than We Found Them

- Engaging culture and creation redemptively and working for the flourishing of all people.
- Scripture: Genesis 2:15; Jeremiah 29:7; Matthew 5:13–16; Philippians 2:3–4; 1 Thessalonians 5:11

2. Reject Passivity, Fight for Holiness, and Return Quickly to the Lord

- Pursuing purity, repenting humbly, and walking in restored grace and renewed purpose.
- Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:22; Romans 12:1–2; Psalm 51:10–12; 1 John 1:9

3. Steward Our Bodies, Minds, Appetites, Time, and Calling with Discipline and Discernment

- Guarding our hearts, training our digital appetites for truth and beauty, and offering every part of our lives as worship.
- Scripture: 1 Corinthians 6:19–20; Philippians 4:8; Psalm 101:3; 1 Timothy 4:7–8; Romans 12:1–2; Ephesians 5:15–17

4. Honor Women and Pursue Sexual Integrity

- Treating every woman with Christlike respect, rejecting lust and objectification, and walking in purity of heart, mind, and body.
- Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 4:3–5; Job 31:1; Matthew 5:8; 1 Timothy 5:1–2

5. Serve Sacrificially in the Church, Community, and Kingdom of God

- Offering our time, talents, and treasure for His glory and the good of others, gathering faithfully, and advancing His Kingdom in every sphere of life.
- Scripture: Hebrews 10:24–25; Romans 12:4–8; 1 Peter 4:10; Philippians 2:3–4; Matthew 5:13–16



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6. Lead With a Shepherd's Heart and a Warrior's Courage

- Guiding with compassion, standing firm in truth, and taking responsibility for our lives and leadership.
- Scripture: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14; Galatians 6:4-5; Psalm 23

7. Honor the Image of God in Every Person

- Treating others with dignity and respect, forgiving freely, and speaking life-giving words that build others up.
- Scripture: Genesis 1:27; John 13:35; Micah 6:8; Matthew 5:9; Ephesians 4:29

8. Live as Disciples of Jesus, Fully Identifying Ourselves in Him

- Loving God's Word, practicing it through prayer and obedience, proclaiming Christ boldly, and multiplying His character and calling in others.
- Scripture: Ezra 7:10; Psalm 119:9-11; Matthew 28:19-20; 2 Timothy 2:2; James 1:22-25; Colossians 3:16

9. Live as Joyful Warriors with the Mind of Christ, Enduring Suffering with Hope and Advancing God's Kingdom

- Fighting for what is good, true, and beautiful in every sphere of life, trusting God's refining work, counting it all joy in trials, building godly culture, and comforting others with the comfort we've received.
- Scripture: Nehemiah 8:10; Isaiah 61:4; Romans 5:3-5; James 1:2-4; 2 Corinthians 1:3-5; 1 Corinthians 2:16

10. Embrace Discipline and Diligence, Sharpening One Another, and Working with Faithfulness for God's Glory

- Welcoming correction as a path to growth, respecting godly authority, rejecting apathy, and building habits of excellence in effort, attitude, and initiative—so that every part of our lives reflects joyful stewardship and godly ambition.
- Scripture: Proverbs 27:17; Hebrews 12:9-11; Ephesians 6:1-3; Proverbs 6:6-11; Colossians 3:23-24; Romans 12:11; Ephesians 5:15-17; Psalm 90:12; 2 Timothy 1:9



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
